#### MESSAGE 11

# The Rapture, The Church, and Israel

#### Revelation 2-3

AS WE CONTINUE IN THE BOOK OF REVELATION, getting a prophetic overview as a framework may be helpful. Scripture teaches that the next event in God's prophetic calendar is the rapture of the church. So let's consider the rapture, how it relates to the church, how it relates to the nation of Israel, and how it fits into the book of Revelation.

#### **The Rapture**

• A generation of followers of the Lord Jesus will not die but will be raptured into the presence of the Lord.

But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep. <sup>15</sup> For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage one another with these words. — 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18

#### **Four Important Aspects of the Rapture**

- At the rapture, Jesus comes for His followers (John 14:1–3).
- At the rapture, there will be a supernatural transformation (1 Corinthians 15:51–53).
- At the rapture, believers will be forever with the Lord (1 Thessalonians 4:17).
- The rapture may occur at any moment (Philippians 3:20, Titus 2:13, James 5:7–9).

#### The Tribulation

- The rapture and Christ's return to the earth are separated by the Tribulation.
- There is a difference between the rapture (1 Thessalonians 4:13–18) and Christ's return in power and glory (Revelation 19).
- Jesus is coming back for the church prior to the Tribulation.

But in Revelation, Scripture offers us the opportunity to look into heaven and learn about the future for followers of Christ who will love, know, and worship the infinite and inexhaustible God.

IN THE THRONE ROOM OF GOD, the worship builds to a magnificent climax. Chapters 4 and 5 are the heavenly prologue to the Tribulation period described in chapters 6 through 18. Only from the perspective of heaven can we understand what will occur on earth.

#### **The Setting**

• In the throne room of God, no one is found worthy to open the scroll (v 1–4).

#### The Scroll

• The Lamb is worthy to open the scroll (v 5–7).

#### The Song

• The Lamb is worthy to receive all of heaven's praise (v 8–14).

# The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse

#### Revelation 6:1-8

**FOCUSING EXCLUSIVELY ON OUR LIFE HERE** and now can be easy. But followers of Jesus are people with a future. We are people of hope, people bound for eternity! Understanding future events gives a biblical perspective on how we should live on earth. And despite the unpopularity of the subject, God's judgment is coming.

#### The Context of the Seals

- The throne room of God (Revelation 4–5)
- The focus moves from heaven to earth (Revelation 6)

#### The Characteristics of the Seals

- The scroll is sealed with seven seals.
- The sequence of events in Matthew 24:3–8 parallels Revelation 6:1–8.

#### The Chronology of the Seals

#### The Content of the First Four Seals: The Four Horsemen

- The rider on the white horse (v 2)
- The rider on the red horse (v 3–4)
- The rider on the black horse (v 5–6)
- The rider on the pale horse (v 7–8)

# The Wrath of the Lamb

#### Revelation 6:9-17

THE LAMB IS OUR LORD JESUS: the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. But He is also the Lamb who is the judge. Although God is a God of love, He is also a God of justice. He has graciously provided a way of salvation and has given us time and opportunities to repent. But God will not be mocked, and in His timing, judgment will come.

#### **Revelation 7**

CHAPTER SEVEN TAKES PLACE BETWEEN the sixth and seventh seals and can be thought of as an interlude or a parenthesis. Before the final seal is opened, there is this fascinating description of events on the earth and in heaven.

#### The Background

- The setting: a review of the big picture (v 1–3)
- The angels (v 1–2)

#### The 144,000

- Suggestions as to the identity of the 144,000
- The 144,000 are Jewish believers (v 4–8).

#### The Great Multitude in Heaven

- The identity of the great multitude (v 9, 13–14)
- The activity of the great multitude (v 10–17)

What is the role of the four angels?
Why should Israel not be confused with the church of Jesus Christ? What is God's promise regarding the spiritual future of Israel?

#### **MESSAGE 17**

# The Blast of the Trumpets

#### **Revelation 8**

THE LAMB HAS ALREADY OPENED six of the seven seals of the scroll. The seven trumpets come from the seventh seal. Now chapter 8 describes the first four of the trumpet judgments.

#### **Events in Heaven Before the Blast of the Trumpets**

- There is silence in heaven (v 1).
- The seven angels are given the seven trumpets (v 2).
- There is another angel at the altar with the golden censer (v 3–5).

#### The First Four of the Seven Trumpets

During the Tribulation period there are seven seals, seven trumpets, and seven bowls of judgment. The seventh seal contains the seven trumpets, and the seventh trumpet contains the seven bowls. The final judgments of God come from the seven bowls.

- The first trumpet is sounded (v 7).
- The second trumpet is sounded (v 8–9).
- The third trumpet is sounded (v 10–11).
- The fourth trumpet is sounded (v 12–13).

What happens in heaven when the Lamb opens the seventh seal? Why are these events significant?
What portion of the earth is affected by each of the trumpet judgments?
What are some similarities between the first four trumpet judgments and the plagues of Egypt? What do these similarities highlight?

#### **MESSAGE 18**

### Demonic Attack

#### **Revelation 9**

THE TRIBUL ATION PERIOD INVOLVES the opening of seven seals, the blasting of seven trumpets, and the outpouring of seven bowls as the judgment of God is rendered. Revelation 9 deals with the blast of the fifth and sixth trumpets. While the first four trumpet blasts impacted the natural world, the last three trumpets directly impact humanity.

#### The Blast of the Fifth Trumpet

- A star fallen from heaven to earth is given the key to the bottomless pit (v 1).
- The locusts from the pit (v 3–11)

#### The Blast of the Sixth Trumpet

- The release of the four angels (v 13–15)
- The army of 200 million (v 16–19)
- The response of mankind (v 20–21)

How are the "locusts" unlike ordinary locusts?
What happens when the four angels are released?
What is the reaction of the people on earth? What activities do they continue?

#### MESSAGE 19

# The Angel with the Little Scroll

#### **Revelation 10**

AFTER THE BLASTS OF THE FIFTH AND SIXTH TRUMPETS and before the seventh trumpet (which contains the seven bowls), there is another interlude similar to the one we saw in Revelation 7 after the sixth seal.

#### **The Mighty Angel**

- His identity
- The mighty angel had a little scroll open in his hand (v 2).

#### The Seven Peals of Thunder

• The mighty angel cries with a loud voice, and seven peals of thunder are heard.

#### The Little Scroll

- John is now instructed to take the scroll (v 8).
- John takes and eats all the scroll.

Describe the mighty angel. Do we know who he is? What does he do?
What is signified by John eating the scroll?

Does it encourage you to know that God is still in charge during this period of judgment?

#### MESSAGE 20

# The Two Witnesses

#### Revelation 11:1–14

IN THIS FIRST SECTION of Revelation 11, we are still in the interlude between the sixth and seventh trumpet. Keep in mind that at the end of the Tribulation, Jesus Christ will return as King of kings and Lord of lords and will set up His millennial kingdom on earth.

#### The Temple

- John is told to "measure the temple of God" (v 1).
- Solomon's temple
- The second temple
- The tribulation temple

#### **The Witnesses**

- Their identity (v 3–4)
- Their power and testimony (v 5–6)
- Their opposition (v 7–10)

THE FIFTH TRUMPET IS THE FIRST WOE. The sixth trumpet is the second woe. Now with the interlude complete, the seventh trumpet — the third woe — is to be blown.

#### The Sequence of the Judgments During the Tribulation

 God's judgment on the earth is contained in seven seals, seven trumpets, and seven bowls.

• The announcement of praise (v 15)

• Israel is the particular object of the dragon's attack (v 13).

The kingdom of the Antichrist will ultimately be destroyed when Jesus Christ returns to set up His kingdom as King of kings and Lord of lords.

THIS CHAPTER IS A PREVIEW OF EVENTS at the end of the Tribulation. The chronology will be resumed in chapter 16 with the seven bowls. There are three visions — now we see the Tribulation from God's perspective. Instead of the devil and the Antichrist, we have the Lamb. Instead of those who follow the Beast, we have those who follow the Lamb.

- The identity of the 144,000 (v 1)
- The activity of the 144,000 (v 2–3)
- The description of the 144,000 (v 4–5)

#### The Announcements of Heaven

- The first angel (v 6–7)
- The second angel (v 8)
